The interface design provides users conveniences such as drag-and-drop functionality, which makes customizing lists and reports very easy. In fact, SiteAudit’s customizable reporting is another of its strengths. Users can construct complex queries against the database and quickly call up data that can easily be filtered by parameters until the information displayed in the report is exactly what the user was seeking. Version 6 introduced a range of enhancements, such as dashboards that

provide at-a-glance details and an optional Excel plug-in that allows users to run “what-if” scenarios based on actual data. And those are in addition to other useful tools such as the ability to calculate utilization, uptime and downtime for a specific time period, cost per page analysis and much more.
